

We are excited to announce that Caseys Beach Holiday Park will be re-opening to tourism from Monday 11th October.

Under the Public Health Order, caravan parks and camping grounds can be open to fully vaccinated persons and unvaccinated persons.

Please ensure you read the following information and understand your obligations in following the restrictions on travel that apply to you as set under the current Public Health Order as per the Reopening NSW Roadmap.

From 11 October 2021:

Unvaccinated persons can only take a holiday in a caravan park or camping ground if the caravan park or camping ground is in the same LGA in which the person resides. Unvaccinated persons are not allowed to access onsite premises that must be closed to unvaccinated adults.

Vaccinated persons who reside in Greater Sydney can take a holiday in a caravan park or camping ground located in Greater Sydney, but not outside Greater Sydney. Vaccinated persons are allowed to access the onsite premises that must be closed to unvaccinated adults.


Vaccinated persons who reside outside Greater Sydney can take a holiday in a caravan park or camping ground located outside Greater Sydney, but not in Greater Sydney. Vaccinated persons are allowed to access the onsite premises that must be closed to unvaccinated adults.

Premises CLOSED to unvaccinated adults:

If a caravan park or camping ground has on site any of the premises listed under clause 2.18 of the Order, an unvaccinated adult must not be on those premises and occupiers of those premises must take reasonable steps to ensure that an unvaccinated adult is not on the premises. For Caseys Beach Holiday Park this includes the swimming pool, and proof of vaccination evidence may be requested of adults entering this area.

Long-term casual occupants

Clause 6.6 of the Order, which places restrictions on people taking holidays as set out above, applies also to long-term casual occupants, their guests and other visitors. In addition, unvaccinated persons are not allowed to access onsite premises that must be closed to unvaccinated adults.



Permanent residents

The Order does not require permanent residents to be vaccinated. However, there are restrictions on visitors to places of residence. Residents can have up to 5 visitors at any one time, so long as all the adults (residents and visitors) are vaccinated. If a resident at a residential site is unvaccinated, visitors are not allowed at that residential site.

However, a person is authorised to be at the place of residence (regardless of vaccination status) for any of the following purposes:-

- to carry out work,
- to assist a person moving to or from the place of residence,
- for childcare,
- for carer's responsibilities, to provide care or assistance to a vulnerable person or for compassionate reasons,
- for family contact arrangements,
- because of an emergency or to avoid an injury, illness or risk of harm,
- to inspect the place of residence for sale or lease or to participate in an auction of the place of residence.

In addition, unvaccinated persons are not allowed to access onsite premises that must be closed to unvaccinated adults.

Masks are required indoors in communal park areas and at Reception with certain exceptions, such as if a person has an illness, condition or disability that makes wearing a mask unsuitable.

Mandatory electronic check ins are required using the Service NSW COVID Safe Check-in QR code system.
